Communion Tokens

In the Scottish Presbyterian Church, it was the custom the day before the Communion Service to issue a token, or pass, usually of lead or pewter, to the intending communicants.

The custom arose in the days of the Covenanters, to eliminate government spies.

They date officially at least back to 1635.

The tokens are usually stamped with the names of the parish.

The earliest are square, and bear nothing but the initial of the parish; the later one bear a date and the minister's initials.


